

helloBEEprusa Challenge Terms and Regulations

1. THE CHALLENGE

BEEVERYCREATIVE recently launched the helloBEEprusa 3D printer. It's a version of a well-known open source 3D printer (see <https://beeverycreative.com/hellobeeprusa-3d-printer/>).

The source of this project is available here: <https://github.com/beeverycreative>.

We challenge you to develop an add-on or improvement to the kit's system!

It can be something that already exists for other printers or something completely new, provided that it adapts to the helloBEEprusa model.

The best project submitted in accordance with these terms and regulations has the chance to win a helloBEEprusa 3D printer.

A few examples:

- Auto-calibration;
- Low-power LASER module;
- Paste extruder;
- Whatever your imagination can come up with.

2. DEADLINE

Projects have to be delivered by 14th October, 2015.

3. CONDITIONS OF PARTICIPATION

a) All participants and visitors of the event Maker Faire Rome may join this challenge. Only the entries that comply with these terms and regulations will be considered and assessed.

b) To enter the challenge, projects must be sent by email to: ideas@beeverycreative.com, by 14th October, 2015 and contain:

- Subject: helloBEEprusa CHALLENGE;
- Personal Data: Name, Email, Mobile Number and Full Address;
- Information about the project: Project's Name; Project's Description; Drawings of the components (stl; STEP; etc); List of Parts; Images.

c) Each participant may enter the challenge with more than one project to be assessed by the jury.

d) Projects developed by teams will be accepted. In this case, there should be a team leader properly identified when submitting the project, to whom the prize will be handed to, should their winning participation is selected by the jury.

e) The projects may be submitted in a form of an incomplete proof of concept, and if so, the submission must include a document explaining the goals intended to be reached at the end of the project. In the case where this happens with the winning participation, its author is obliged to complete the project by 31st December, 2015.

6. JURY AND SELECTION CRITERIA

The jury is made up by BEEVERYCREATIVE's R&D team.

The projects will be classified by the following criteria:

- Project's creativity;
- Project's feasibility;
- Technical implementation;

7. PRIZE

The best project will win a helloBEEprusa 3D printer. The prize will be given on the last day of the event, 18th October.

NOTE: The prize will only be given away if the jury acknowledges merit in the project.

8. INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY

The participants in this challenge guarantee:

- i. The project submitted is original and hasn't been submitted or made public by any means;
- ii. The project submitted does not violate intellectual property rights of third parties, being the participant responsible for all and any damages caused by violating these rights;
- iii. That the project is submitted with an MIT open source license. (More information at <http://opensource.org/licenses/MIT>).

9. FINAL PROVISIONS

BEEVERYCREATIVE can cancel or change the rules of the present challenge in case of force majeure and without need of prior notice. In this case, the participants will not have the right to any compensation or claim.

BEEVERYCREATIVE has the right to exclude all fraudulent participations, as well as to cancel the attribution of a prize.

BEEVERYCREATIVE shall not be liable for any human or technical error that may occur during this challenge.
